## Sample Kindergarten / Very Early Emergent Book

### Level 2

Word count this book: 50

Story about Victor, one of several recurring characters

Large font, lots of space between words and lines, short sentences

The refrain (*We have*) introduced here and reinforced later

High frequency word (*is*), introduced earlier, reinforced here and later

Students will chuckle at the rivalry between Victor and his sister.

Like the words *chicken* (page 2) and *salad* (page 4), the challenging word (*rice*) is cued by the illustration.

Challenging word (*milk*) cued by illustration

We have chicken.  
Chicken is hot.



We have salad.  
Salad is cold.




We have rice.  
Rice is hot.




We have milk.  
Milk is cold.




Challenging word (*corn*)
